

## OH&S Announces 2017 New Product of the Year Award Winners.

DALLAS, September 6, 2017 – Nineteen companies, including multiple winner Honeywell, were honored today for winning *Occupational Health & Safety* magazine's ninth annual New Product of the Year contest.
